The voice of the heart expresses our thankfulness, attests to our commitment, shares our joy and our sorrow, and draws us nearer to one another and to our Savior. Oh, how I missed the unifying sound of our hearts when we were unable to worship together. I find it so uplifting to be able to speak together as one voice in worshipful song.

Psalm 47:6-7 encourages us to let the voice of our hearts be heard: "Sing praises to God, sing praises to our King, sing praises. For God is the King of all the earth; sing to Him a psalm of praise."

May we never hesitate to let the voice of our heart be heard, even if by no one else than Almighty God.
