

# North Park's New Adventure is Here! Ready?!

<u>In approximately 2 years since March of 2020:</u>

- COVID affected all our lives and in March 2020 affected the way we met and we found a way to meet <u>outside</u> for, I think it was, 10 Sundays in a row (also must be a record for sunny Sundays in a row for Rockford! Rockford, you are welcome. It's because God wanted us to meet!) And it still affects us halfway through 2022: no communion or contribution tray passing, chair configuration, some in masks, ionic air purifiers, people with sniffles stay home, we still meet less and gather at our building together ...less. : (

- Tim Firm appointed 4 elders in August 2020 after we were without for several years, and they

in-turn appointed new ministry leaders and deacons

- In 2021 we slowly crept back from 2 services to 1 service, eventually to judgment-free zone masking policies and the chairs started to magically move closer together again until we settled in at an average attendance of around 125 at Sunday worship services. Thanks be to God that we never had a COVID outbreak from our services, and members that got it elsewhere lovingly stayed home that week. Thank you, God, that we had no members die of COVID so far. Many thanks to the AntiVirus Team ("A-Team") for all the planning, efforts and nudges to sanitize and mask and distance, but only as long as we had to.

- Tim & Cathy Firm retired in 2022 and as of June have moved away to live near their girls after many years of being a strong force in the direction of North Park, helping keeping it alive when many northern, and everywhere else, congregations and churches of all kinds closed

their doors.

- Ashley Gregory, who's been our Ministry Assistant and main communication point for the church for about 8 years is migrating to another job outside the church by the end of 2022, being replaced by new Mama Katrina Whaley.

- In June of this year, the elders have hired a new minister who starts August 7<sup>th</sup>!

#### Time for our New Adventure to begin!

Bear with me while I do that thing you should do with your kids before you go to a relative's house for the first time (or every time, act.), which is trying to help set their expectations of what's about to happen, like: "Okay, kids, we're almost to Aunt Agnes' house. She has a cat that doesn't like to be petted. Only sit on the furniture with the plastic covers on them. Take your shoes off on the mat at the door. Use your inside voice unless she says to speak up. Don't run in the house, because you might break something in her nice displays ('nice displays' = a nice way to say 'clutter'). She always has ice cream and cookies and if we're good, she'll offer you some. Say please and thank you." Why should the poor kids get put in time out for not knowing they shouldn't sit on the chair with no plastic cover..."it looked comfy to me and nobody was sitting there!"

No. Obviously, nobody's getting put in time out when Roddy comes, but, in preparation, the elders want us ALL to be thinking and praying about the new opportunities we each have with these changes that have changed our whole leadership and office. We are asking the congregation to pray daily about having your hearts and minds in a gear to be ready to support Roddy as our minister when he starts August 7. There will be things showing up on the church website and in announcement sheets to prepare for his first sermon series. He has a Sunday plan through next February already! As a member of Christ's church since your baptism, commit today to whatever things he and we propose and see what happens. Pray to have an open mind, open heart and openness to change. Open up your schedule to whatever is scheduled and show up. Decide now that you will do all readings or 'homework' given. Volunteer for any things that need volunteers. Don't hide any talents under a bush...even if you think your only talent is showing up! Get out of your comfort zone if asked to help with something different ("I can do all things through Christ who gives me strength", right...so, if I'm not willing to get out of my comfort zone, then who is in control of my life, really?)

Imagine if the things we all decide now to commit to and participate in and say 'Yes!' to actually lead us to a better place in our walks with God and with each other, and then Jesus-seekers show up here and see it and start saying to themselves: "I know they are all different from each other in age, in talents, in jobs, in where they are from, in what sports teams they like, etc., but their ability to be so devoted to one another in worship and work together is proof that they are Jesus' followers. I need to be part of it and find out how to be one, too!" (Hint: In John 13:34-35 Jesus says this is what should happen!)
