

LOVE ONE ANOTHER

"What the world needs now, is love, sweet love. No, not just for some, but for everyone." Those are some of the lyrics to a song written by Burt Bacharach, released in April 1965. It was performed by Jackie DeShannon, as well as Dionne Warwick. Fifty-five years later, love is still needed and perhaps even to a greater degree today.

As Christians, one of the most beautiful songs we sing is "The Greatest Commands". The harmony is amazing, usually leaving me unable to sing all of the song because I become one giant goose-bump. As each part is added to the song and the sound of voices singing their individual section increases with each verse, the song becomes more and more moving. Just what is the source of the song's power . . . the words, the sound we produce, the way the song is written, the message of the song? Read the words to the song (all the words). We tend to focus on our own individual part when we sing and may miss out on the complete message of the song.

"Love one another for love is of God. He who loves is born of God and knows God. He who does not love does not know God, for God is love, God is love. Love bears all things, Believes all things, Love hopes all things, Endures all things. God is love, G

Read those words again, even if the melody works its way into the reading, try to focus on the words. Powerful! Upon further review, perhaps the intent of the song is really the essence of what love should be . . . when everyone brings their different parts together to create such a beautiful song, isn't that the very picture of love? Unity, harmony, beauty . . . what makes the song so wonderful to hear is what should make love so wonderful to experience. Each individual part is okay but the song only becomes powerful, moving, goose-bump creating when those individual parts form one song. Love should be no different. When we unite, when we live in harmony, then our actions result in beauty rather than ugliness and we experience the true message found in the words of the song and illustrated by the blending of our voices.

As Christians, as God's children, we should be making sure that every word we write in the song of our lives reflects the message written in I John 4:7-8: "Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God. Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love." Just think of the unity, the harmony, the beauty that can result when our part blends with each other's part. So, just what is the source of power in this song . . . the words, the sound we produce, the way the song is written, the message of the song? YES! When love exists, harmony is present, and beauty is seen by everyone. What a powerful result.
