

REAL PROSPERITY GOSPEL "PROSPERITIES": CONFIDENCE

In the two-part series of sermons in May called The REAL Prosperity Gospel, I had an impossible time sharing all the clearly stated ways God's Word says we followers of Jesus actually prosper. There are just too many obvious ones and I'm sure that I didn't even locate all of them! So, here's another I didn't get to: Confidence!

I present to you Hebrews 4:15-16: "For we do not have a high priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet he did not sin. 16 Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.

We approach the throne of Grace (where God sits. SQUIRREL! I looked it up and He does <u>sit</u>!—In 1 Kings 22:19 and 2 Chronicles 18:18, in the vision Micaiah is recounting to Ahab and Jehoshaphat, he says "I saw the LORD *sitting* on his throne with all the multitudes of heaven standing around him on his right and on his left.", so unless he was making that up, and Micaiah was 'a real character', with sarcasm appearing to be his superpower, it must be true: that God *sits* on a throne. See! All important facts (?) ARE in the Bible if you look for them. The account in 1 Kings 22 always cracks me up because of the exchange between Micaiah and Ahab, the biggest crybaby wimp-husband in the whole Bible—you should read it and let the theater of your mind star Ryan Reynolds or Robert Downey Jr. as Micaiah, or maybe Steve Martin, if you are of the Baby Boomer or Greatest Generation...so yes, yes, God <u>does sit</u> on a throne, at least in visions to men.)....

Anyway, back to <u>Confidence</u>, we are either instructed or encouraged by the Hebrew writer to come to God with confidence...and get mercy and grace in our time of need. I notice that it does NOT say to come with confidence on days I'm feeling close to God spiritually or on Sunday or after I've had a good prayer time and feeling accomplished that I read 2 whole chapters of difficult-name genealogy chapters in Leviticus. No! It says to come to God with confidence to get *mercy* and *grace*. And, it does not say to come during God's weekly office hours; it says to come in your time of need. So, "Whenevs", WHENEVER I need mercy and grace.

Here's are the other areas of life we are to be confident in, from very clear Bible (the source of all absolute truth) verses:

Ephesians 3:12 "In him and through faith in him we may approach God with freedom and confidence." Gee, he doesn't even have to be sitting on the throne for us to approach! It could be while He's having a sammy or laughing at The Good Place on Netflix. (I'm totally kidding... sorta)

1 Jn 4:17 "This is how love is made complete among us so that we will have confidence on the day of judgment: In this world we are like Jesus." Yoda would say: "Have confidence on judgment day, you should'.....because YOU are living your life being like Jesus!

1 Jn 5:14 "This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us." So, the only boundary on what we can ask Dad is whether it is according to *His will*. I know that asking every day to be partly puffy-cloudy 70 degrees with a light Southwesterly breeze is probably not in His will, but the Bears making the playoffs this year might be—you never know. Seriously, we certainly should be asking for that friend or relative to get an open heart so they can be saved or for that friend captive to sin would be granted repentance, or for *our own* repentance. Those would be in God's will and we should be asking for that. And, anything else we ask, respectful of His will, even if we aren't sure if it is in His will (in His Plans for us or them or it), is still okay to ask and the outcome will let us know whether it was or wasn't. Who knows, but God? It was fine for me to ask Dad for mini-bike when the Kellett boys had one, but it wasn't in my dad's "will" for me to have one so I didn't. And I'm still alive today (because it didn't kill me not to get it and because I didn't die ...on it!)

Enjoy the prosperity of Confidence before God for mercy and grace and confidence of your judgment day status this month andalways!
