

A DATE THAT LIVES ON...

June 9, 1956 is a date that is very important in my life. That was the day Kenneth Firm and Martha Arline Norris got married. This June 9th would have marked 65 years of marriage for them; not a record by any means, but still very significant for my two younger brothers and for me. Yes, there is the obvious reason . . . without that marriage then Tim, Scott, and Doug Firm would very likely not have been *Tim*, *Scott and Doug Firm*.

However, there is an even more important reason associated with that date. When I was 7 years old, my dad and mom became Christians. In fact, I can still remember asking my grandma after an evening service during a Gospel Meeting where dad and mom were and she said they were being baptized. I wasn't exactly sure what that meant at the time.

My dad was not brought up in a godly home; my mom was, but had not made a spiritual commitment to the Lord yet. I can still remember attending a few different churches when I was small, on a hit or miss basis, until this whole "church thing" took on a much greater emphasis in our family. We started attending church services all the time, talk about God and Jesus became more commonplace in the car and at home, and we even started praying before meals. In addition, the friendships that were formed with other Christians became the center of our families "social activities" on a weekly basis.

While from a physical standpoint June 9, 1956 was significant, from a spiritual standpoint it was of even greater importance because I believe God began working on the hearts of my dad and mom early in their marriage. In essence, my brothers and I enjoyed the blessings of being brought up in a Christian home, which laid a solid foundation for our own lives. Don't get me wrong, none of us are perfect—I'm far from it and have made my share of mistakes in life—but we are well-grounded, have a solid understanding of things like faith, hope, and love; embrace the importance of loving God and loving others; learned first-hand from our parents how to serve others; appreciate the sacrifice that Jesus made on our behalf; and fully believe in the importance of a Christian home.

As a result of June 9, 1956 and all that has happened in the years since; Sara, Ryan, Kyle, Kailey, and Jeremy Firm were born into Christian homes too. None of us should ever underestimate the significance of a Christian home and the positive spiritual impact that such a place can have on its children and on their children and on their children's children.

The line from the song, *God Give Us Christian Homes*, reads "God give us Christian homes! Homes where the children are led to know, Christ in His beauty who loves them so."
