# PERFECTION

David was considered a great leader; he is still considered a great leader. He was also considered a man after God's own heart. However, David had his flaws as well. He was imperfect and committed sins like humans tend to do. Yet, God chose David to serve the nation of Israel as its king.

We are moving toward considering men who we would want to follow as elders of the North Park church. The Bible provides us with qualities desirous of those who would serve as elders; however none of the qualities found in the New Testament include "perfection". If it is perfection that we require of men in order for them to become elders then we will not find anyone living today who will meet that standard.

Even the apostles, those closest to Jesus, who spent so much time learning from Jesus, seeing what Jesus represented and hearing what Jesus taught could not be found to be "perfect". They were flawed. Try as they might, they were human and as humans they were prone to make mistakes, to sin. Even though they were imperfect men, Jesus still charged them with carrying out what we call "The Great Commission" (Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-16). Imperfect men were given the responsibility of carrying the gospel message throughout the known world.

Too often we say we want elders, we say we want to be aligned with how the New Testament church should be organized, yet we place unreal expectations on those who may be considered to serve in that role. As soon as we want to place a title of "elder" on someone, too often members of the body no longer consider them worthy of providing the leadership they may have been providing to the church and that we were fine with them providing right up until the time we are about to call them "an elder".

I'm not implying or even stating that we ignore the qualities listed in I Timothy 3, Titus 1, and I Peter 5. Those qualities are there to describe what we need to seek in the men who we would consider becoming elders of the North Park Church of Christ. They need to be men that we, as members/as sheep, are willing to follow as shepherds of our congregation of believers. We need to focus on <u>our</u> congregation and on which men of <u>our</u> congregation come the closest to possessing the qualities needed to lead us, as presented in I Timothy, Titus, and I Peter.

Perhaps we should focus more of our attention on how we can be the best "sheep" we can possibly be in order to support those who would become our shepherds and be thankful that we are not required to be perfect sheep.

May God bless us in our efforts and bless those who would provide the best spiritual leadership to our congregation.
